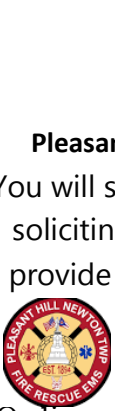

Ordinance Committee presented on golf cart ordinance to council, to be fun and keep everyone safe!

Common ordinance violations you may not know!

- Mowing grass in public right a-way; streets, sidewalks, grass mowed before 7 inches tall.
- Visible cars on personal property need to have up to date tags, and if and if not moved regularly, or inoperable, need to be garaged.
- Trash cans cannot be stored on street, need to move after collection on Friday to, preferably, non-visible sight on your property.
- Sidewalks are public right-a-ways, not for storage
- Exterior maintenance notices are being distributed, financial help may be available, just call office for the contact information.
