Village office and Department Updates for 2024...

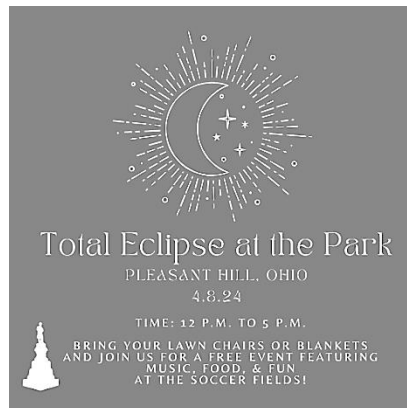

Village Wide Garage Sale – Saturday, April, 27th

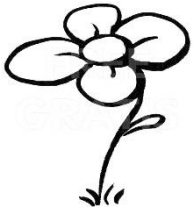
Join in the fun of getting to know you neighbors, grabbing a snack, and most of all, sharing your treasures with others to enjoy!
