*If payment is not received by the Payment due date, a Red TAG Notice will be issued, the amount noted on the bill will be due by 8:00 am of the scheduled shut off day posted on the Red TAG Notice.

Village Street Sweeping

Starting the week of August 8-12, 2022, the Village has contracted to have the streets swept. We will do our best to notify residents of the actual date, which will be based off of weather. Notification will be provided on the Village Website and Village Facebook page.

Street Sweeping provides two primary benefits to the village. The more obvious benefit is the collection and removal of paper, leaves, and other visible debris that collect in the gutters. This debris can block storm water facilities, causing localized flooding during heavy rains. An equally important, but less visible benefit is the removal of metal particles and other hazardous waste products left by passing vehicles. Although they are virtually invisible, these particles can be extremely harmful to fish and other wildlife if they reach our creeks and rivers. The Village encourages residents in the designated areas to move their parked cars off the street before the sweeping date to allow street sweeping crews room to clean streets.

Reminder to Pet (Dog) Owners

All pet owners and keepers are requested to keep their pets on a leash and immediately and properly dispose of their pet's solid waste deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by the person. On any property owned or possessed by that person, all pet owners and keepers are requested to dispose of their pet's solid waste at a frequency of at least weekly or more frequently if necessary to prevent a public health nuisance.

Hydrant Flushing Program – July 11-14, 2022

The Village of Pleasant Hill Public Works Department will be flushing and exercising fire hydrants the week of July 11-14, 2022. Plan is to exercise the hydrants between the hours of 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. These times may vary. This is a vital process to ensure the hydrants are in good working order for when they are needed most. This will also remove any accumulated sediment that is built up in the pipes and help insure the cleanest water possible.

You may experience lower than normal water pressure and a short period of water discoloration during flushing and shortly thereafter. Though the water may be discolored, it is safe to drink. Should you experience rusty colored water, we suggest you run the cold water from the faucet nearest to the water meter (laundry tub, outside faucet) to flush the service. However, until the water runs clear, it is advisable to avoid washing clothes, especially white fabrics. If any rust stains appear on your wet laundry, **do not dry your clothes**. Simply run the cold water in your house or at a hose until it is clear and then wash clothing again. This will flush any rusty water out of your water service line. Never run warm or hot water immediately after a hydrant has been flushed, as this could lead to sediment getting into your water heater. **Normally rusty water events dissipate in 4-6 hours but could last longer depending on water usage in the area.**
