Village Leaf Pick-Up – Starting First Week of October

The Pleasant Hill Street Dept. will be picking up leaves Monday thru Friday each week starting First Week of October until the first Friday in December. Please place bagged leaves in the lawn side of the curb for pick-up. Do not rake your leaves or lawn waste into the curb gutter or the street; this is a violation of [Ordinance 1074](#). All leaves must be bagged in regular trash bags no larger than 50-gallon size. **NO TRASH, PINE NEEDLES, STICKS, OR FLOWERS.** Any questions call 676-3241 and leave a message.

*Trash/recycling must be placed curbside the night before your scheduled collection. Drivers may not return to residences if materials are unprepared at the scheduled collection time. *Please contact Rumpke at least 24 hours before your regularly scheduled collection to request a large item pick-up for acceptable large items, and/or excessive amounts of trash. Television sets cannot exceed 32 inches for curbside pick-up. Any mattress or upholstered furniture must be completely sealed in disposable plastic for removal. Additional fees may apply.
